82nd Division News

Colors for the 82nd Airborne Division Combat Aviation Brigade were cased inside a hangar at Simmons Army Airfield to symbolize about 1,500 soldiers preparing for an upcoming deployment to the Middle East. The deployment to the U.S. Central Command area of operation was announced earlier in 2023 and is part of a regular rotation of forces. The 1,500 troops, aircraft and ground equipment from the Combat Aviation brigade will continue operations under Combined Joint Task Force-Operation Inherent Resolve to advise, assist and enable partner forces in the region. The mission of Combined Joint Task Force-Operation Inherent Resolve is to defeat Daesh, which is the Arabic acronym for the Islamic State of Iraq and Syria. The troopers from the brigade are expected to be gone for about nine months.
