Chapter Member Highlight David Mauro



Dave delayed entry enlisted in the US Army while a senior in High

School. After graduating from high school, he reported to the Fort Jackson reception center in September, 1978. From there, he then reported to Fort Benning as the 1st one station unit training (OSUT) unit for basic training and advanced infantry training in the old "Harmony Church" area of the post. Upon graduation, Dave then went to airborne school in January, 1979, being assigned to 44th Company. He arrived at the 82nd Airborne Division Reception in February, 1979 and was then assigned to 2^{nd} Brigade, A Company, 2^{nd} Battalion, 325^{th} Parachute Infantry Regiment. Dave served as a rifleman, team leader, squad leader and unit armorer. Dave achieved the rank of E-5 (Sergeant) prior to leaving Fort Bragg in September, 1982. Dave was also awarded the Good Conduct medal, the Army Commendation medal and the Army Achievement medal and had been named brigade and battalion trooper of the year during his time in the 82nd. After Fort Bragg, Dave served as a reserve drill sergeant with the 78th Training Division. Dave retired from a law enforcement career as a Detective Lieutenant with the Morris County Sheriff's office after 26 years. Dave and his wife Melissa reside in Mount Olive, where they raised their two sons, Bill and Nick. Dave is an active member of the NJ - CPL Steven Koch Chapter of the 82^{nd} Airborne Division Association, 325th Infantry Regiment Association, American Legion Post 164 and is also a member of the American Legion Riders and the Blue Knights NJ8.

Bataan Memorial Death March 2023

The Bataan Memorial Death March occurred on March 19, 2023. This memorial march was coordinated by the Special Forces Group #19, of New Jersey, which conducted the opening ceremony, honoring the 1000 American and 9000 Filipino allies that died at the hands of their Japanese captors during the forced march in April 1942. More than 50 people participated in the March, including active duty soldiers from Fort Dix, members of the Special Forces Group, numerous civilians and several members of our Chapter.

82nd Division News

Several thousand 82nd Airborne Division paratroopers were deployed to Poland in February of last year, amid mounting signs of Russia's intention to invade Ukraine. The paratroopers were there to reassure our NATO allies, deter any potential aggression against NATO's eastern flank, train with hostnation forces, and contribute to a wide range of contingencies. Prior to the 82nd Airborne Division paratroopers' arrival, it had been over seventy-five years since a paratrooper from the division had set foot on the European continent during a period of such tension. Although their predecessors in the division had jumped into combat or rode their gliders into places such as Sicily, Salerno, Anzio, Normandy, Holland, Belgium, and ultimately Germany, last year's deployment brought the paratroopers of the 82nd Airborne Division to a new country to add to its lineage: Poland.
