

# Combat Brigade from 82nd Airborne Division to return from Korea deployment

The 1st Squadron, 17th Cavalry Regiment, part of the 82nd Combat Aviation Brigade, 82nd Airborne Division, conducted its last training exercise in Korea earlier this year. The squadron being replaced in South Korea by the 1st Squadron, 6th Heavy Attack Reconnaissance Squadron from Fort Riley, Kansas. About 350 soldiers from the Fort Bragg squadron have been deployed to Korea, based at Camp Humphries, since June, 2016 and should be returning to Fort Bragg shortly. In Korea, the unit conducted numerous training exercises with local U.S. Army units and South Korean forces. Once the squadron is back at Fort Bragg, it will be transitioning to the AH-64D Apache helicopter.
