Chapter Member Highlight Frank Fisler

After graduating from high school In 1979, Frank enlisted in the US

Army and was sent to Fort Bliss in El Paso, Texas for Basic Training. His MOS was 16R - Vulcan Air Defense Systems and 16P - Handheld Stinger Air Defense Systems. After graduating basic training, Frank was sent to Lackland Air Force Base in Lackland, Texas where he attended classes in security training. Once Frank completed the security training, he went to Airborne School in Fort Benning. After completing airborne training, Frank was assigned to Fort Bragg with the 82nd Airborne Division. Frank had many different assignments and training while at Fort Bragg. Frank ended his active military career in 1985 and then joined the New Jersey National Guard, 50th Military Police Company at Fort Dix. In the National Guard Frank trained to become a Military Police Officer. Frank resigned from the National Guard in 1992. He married in 1991 and had two children. Frank then became a grandfather in 2023. Franks states that he is honored to serve his country and is proud to be a member of the 82nd Airborne Division. Frank states that he went into the military as a naïve young man and left a proud and humble veteran.

Veterans Benefits

The deadline to enroll in the Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP), the plan that allows for surviving spouses and children to any continuation of the military retirement pay after the death of the soldier, has been announced to be December 31. The Defense Finance and Accounting Service, or DFAS, announced in late September that it wants potential enrollees to start the process of buying into the program or opting out by Nov. 1. Typically, the decision whether to enroll in SBP is made at the time of military retirement. For this open season, almost all military retirees may revisit their SBP decision. The first step is to submit a Letter of Intent to DFAS before Nov. 1. This is a nonbinding inquiry to get more specific information for your situation. DFAS will calculate your buy-in amount, monthly premiums and projected benefits. At that point, you can decide whether you want to proceed.

82nd Airborne Division Deployment

Soldiers stationed with the 82nd Airborne Division are being deployed to U.S. Central Command for a routine rotation of forces. The 82nd Airborne Division Combat Aviation Brigade "Pegasus," stationed at Fort Liberty, will replace a Mississippi National Guard aviation brigade. According to the 82nd Airborne, this is a routine rotation of forces in which it is replacing the 185th Expeditionary Combat Aviation Brigade of the Mississippi Army National Guard in Operation Inherent Resolve. The operation supports partnering forces in Iraq and Syria fighting terrorist groups. However, the operation also holds other missions around the world. Officials said the 82nd Airborne has had several deployments for this operation since 2015. They also confirmed about 1,500 troops with aircraft and ground equipment will be sent out for this deployment. The Department of Defense also announced more security assistance for Ukraine in its war with Russia, dispatching air defense, artillery and medical vehicles to support Ukraine.

Norwegian Foot March

Several Chapter members along with members of the Special Forces Chapter 19 of NJ took part in providing support and manning one of the rest stops during the recent Norwegian Foot March that took place at the Naval Air Station in Lakehurst, NJ. The Norwegian military has for years demonstrated their combat readiness by completing a 30-kilometer (18.6 mile) march with combat equipment within a specific time and are then awarded the Foot March medal by the Norwegian Consulate. The marchers started the course at midnight and marched the designated route within the Lakehurst Base. The final results of the 90 participants are 37 who completed the course under the required time, 31 who completed the course over the required time and 22 who did not complete the course.

A U.S. Army-led High Mobility Artillery Rocket System, or HIMARS, live-fire exercise demonstrated the weapons system's capabilities and enhanced allied interoperability with NATO allies in Estonia, Sept. 27, 2023. U.S. Army Soldiers with Task Force Voit, assigned to 3rd Battalion, 27th Field Artillery Regiment, 18th Field Artillery Brigade, 82nd Airborne Division, supporting the 3rd Infantry Division, demonstrated M142 HIMARS operations to multinational troops comprising NATO's enhanced Forward Presence Battle Group Estonia during the exercise. Task Force Voit Soldiers support the 3rd Infantry Division-led Task Force Marne. The 3rd Infantry Division's mission is to continue working alongside NATO allies and regional security partners to provide combatcredible forces to V Corps, America's forward deployed corps in Europe.
