Infantry of 11th

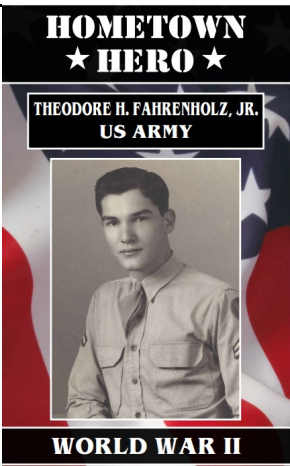
Airborne Corps

During Ted’s time in the Philippines, his company was tasked with the liberation of the Japanese Los Banos civilian detention camp located in the Philippines. The Los Banos camp was a centralized camp where the Japanese had moved all non-native civilian personnel during their time of occupation. Overseen by Japanese military forces, this camp was slowly starving the captured civilians by way of severe meal rationing, even though the locals had offered food for the camp. Just prior to the liberation of the camp by the 511th, the Japanese were making plans for the extermination of all remaining civilians to cover-up any knowledge of the war crimes they had committed. Ted and his fellow 511th Airborne comrades saved the lives of over a 2000 civilians.

West Point Football Run

Once again, the 511th Airborne Troop sent Chemical Troop to participate in the West Point Annual football run, bringing the game ball from West Point to the site of this year’s game, Philadelphia. The West Point team of cadets will run the 150 miles to deliver the game ball. The Army Black Knights have a two game winning streak and look to continue their dominance over the rival Midshipmen.

82nd Troopers re-enact WWII River Crossing

Participants from the 307th Engineer Battalion simulated the Waal River crossing of World War II at McKellars Lake on Fort Bragg. Simulated machine gun fire and simulated artillery added to the realistic nature of the reenactment. The September 20, 1944 mission was part of Operation Market Garden and included both the 307th and the 504th PIR. The World War II paratroopers constructed never before seen British boats for their crossing. When the mission ended, the paratroopers achieved the objective of claiming the bridge, although about 50 troopers lost their lives in the battle. The bridge was significant in the allied assault on the German lines in the Netherlands and Germany.
