## Route 173 designated as 173rd Airborne Brigade Highway

Route 173, which runs along Interstate 78 between Clinton and Phillipsburg, has now been designated the 173rd Airborne Brigade Highway. This honor is bestowed because of the brigade's many years of heroism and sacrifice. The 173rd Infantry Brigade was deployed to France in World War I and later, as the 87th Recon Troop, in World War II. In the early 1960's the brigade was identified as a special airborne task force whose members include 13 medals of Honor and over 130 distinguished service cross recipients.

## **DeVries, Peter**, (1926-2016)

Pete was a U.S. Army combat veteran of World War II and Korea. He was a command sergeant major and served with the 508th PIR - 82nd Airborne Division, 2nd Ranger Battalion, and 10th Special Forces. Pete also trained with the Canadian and British Airborne in England prior to D-Day.

Pete received many awards for valor during his service. Some of them multiple times. Included among them were the Distinguished Service Cross, Silver Star and Purple Heart. He also received several foreign awards. See Pete's award shadow box below. Pete was very active in the North Jersey Chapter

## Fraunberger, Stephen, (1950-2015)

Steve was a U.S. Army combat veteran of the Vietnam War. He served with the 82nd Airborne Division as a company commander in the 505th PIR. Steve was active in veteran's affairs and led our chapter's participation in laying an 82nd wreath at the New Jersey Vietnam Veteran's Memorial at military ceremonies. Steve had a career in law enforcement and retired from the U.S. Marshals Service. Steve was very active in the North Jersey Chapter.
