Chapter Member Highlight Victor Balint



Victor enlisted in the Army in 1970 and volunteered for Airborne Infantry.

Vic was assigned to the 82nd Airborne Division and took par in the NATO Operation "Deep Furrow" in Turkey in 1971. I 1973, Vic joined the Army Reserve and served in the 11th Special Forces, the 78th Division and the 198th Army Securit Agency. He attended Warrant Officer Flight Training in 1979 and graduated as a OH-58 "Kiowa" Pilot and a UH-1 "Huey" Pilot. Vic joined the NJ National Guard in 1987 as a Test Pilot in the AH-1 "Cobra" Attack Helicopter for the 1-150th Attack Helicopter Battalion. In 1995, he joined the NJ Counterdrug Program, working with the FBI, Secret Service DEA, Customs, US Coast Guard, NJ State Police and various city police departments as a OH-58 Counterdrug Pilot. When the World Trade Center was attacked on 9/11, Vic was part of the initial military response and directly supported the FBI. After Hurricane Katrina, Vic deployed to Louisiana and provided helicopter support for the New Orleans Police Department. In 2006, he visited Albania to share aviation maintenance techniques with the Albanian Military. In 2008, he deployed as a UH-60 "Blackhawk" pilo in support of "Operation Iraqi Freedom", where he performed missions throughout Kuwait and southern Iraq. Vic achieved the grade of Master Aviator with over 6500 flight hours. Vic had received numerous awards from the military and various federal, state and law enforcement agencies. Vic's highest accommodation was the awarding of the Legion of Merit in 2011. Vic, and his wife, Andrea, have one daughter and two sons. Both of Vic's sons were members of the 108th Aerial Refueling Wing of the Air National Guard. His youngest son is currently a US Army Blackhawk Pilot.

Veteran's Benefit Information

The National Park Service is making available a new lifetime pass to veterans for free entrance to the National Parks. This in addition to the free annual passes that are available to veterans. This benefit is available to all veterans and Gold Sta family members. Current members of the armed forces are eligible for free annual passes also. The annual and lifetime passes provide free access to more than 100 National Parks, with at least one in every state. For information. visit nps.gov

Don't fall victim to scammers charging for Military Records - They are available free.

Veterans Affairs has noted a substantial increase in scammers offering services to veterans that are otherwise available for free. Scammers have also set up fake websites to charge veterans to access their military records or medical records (i.e., medical identity theft). There is generally no charge for military members and their families to access basic personnel or medical records. Note that any veteran that is in need of getting copies of their military or medical records, those records are available free of charge by contacting the official website. If you're looking for military records, contact the Veterans Administration directly or the National Archives.

New Jersey State Service Medals

The state of New Jersey has several service medals that are awarded to New Jersey Residents that fulfill the qualifications. These medals are awarded by the NJ Veterans Benefits Bureau. Various medals include the New Jersey Distinguished Service medal, the New Jersey Meritorious Service Medal, the New Jersey Korean Service medal, the New Jersey Vietnam Service medal, the New Jersey Desert Storm Service medal and the New Jersey POW/MIA Service medal. 82nd Division News

Paratroopers from the 18th Airborne Corps arrived back at Fort Bragg in late October after an eight-month deployment in Europe. The soldiers, who are part of the 3rd Battalion, 321st Field Artillery Regiment, rapidly deployed to Germany on Feb. 28 in support of the 18th Airborne Corps and the immediate response force's mission to bolster NATOS's eastern flank and support NATO in deterring Russian aggression after Russian invaded the Ukraine. The regiment transferred responsibilities to the 1st Battalion, 14th Field Artillery Regiment from Fort Sill, Oklahoma recently. 82nd Airborne paratroopers returned to Fort Bragg in July, while the 18th Airborne Corps' headquarters has remained in Germany since February. During the deployment, the regiment took part in several training events across Europe including in Germany and Poland.
